

## NSDAR Educational Resources Committee "Our Flag, Symbol of our Nation" Lesson Plan

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State: Utah

Grade Level: Kindergarten

Time Allocation: 45 minutes

- Identify the standards to be addressed: Utah Common Core K. Social Studies, Standard 2 (Citizenship): Students will recognize their roles and responsibilities of being a good citizen. Objective 3 (a) Investigate and explain how symbols and songs unite families and classmates. (b) Recognize state and national symbols. (e.g., state and national flags, bald eagle, seagull, Statue of Liberty).
- 2. Statement of the objective and lesson outcomes: Students will recognize the Flag of the United States of America.
- Materials, resources, and technology to be used by teacher/students: Book on the flag such as My Name is Old Glory by Martha Laguardia-Kotite and Trish Marx, The American Flag by Tyles Monroe, The U.S. Flag: Introducing Primary Sources by Kathryn Clay, Our Flag by Congress (U.S.), Joint Committee on Printing, etc. – Flag coloring sheet: <u>http://www.crayola.com/free-coloring-pages/print/united-states-flag-coloring-page/</u> or <u>http://www.coloringcastle.com/pdfs/flags/flag-usa.pdf</u>. - U.S. Flag to display
- 4. Introduction of the topic: Display the flag and ask students what it is and what they know about it. Then read the book about the U. S. Flag.
- 5. **Procedure for instruction**: Concept 1 this is the Flag of the United States of America. Concept 2 it has 13 red and white stripes representing the original 13 colonies and a field of blue with 50 stars representing the 50 states of the USA.
- 6. Lesson closure: Students do a coloring page of the U. S. Flag
- 7. Assessment of student understanding: Completion of coloring page.
